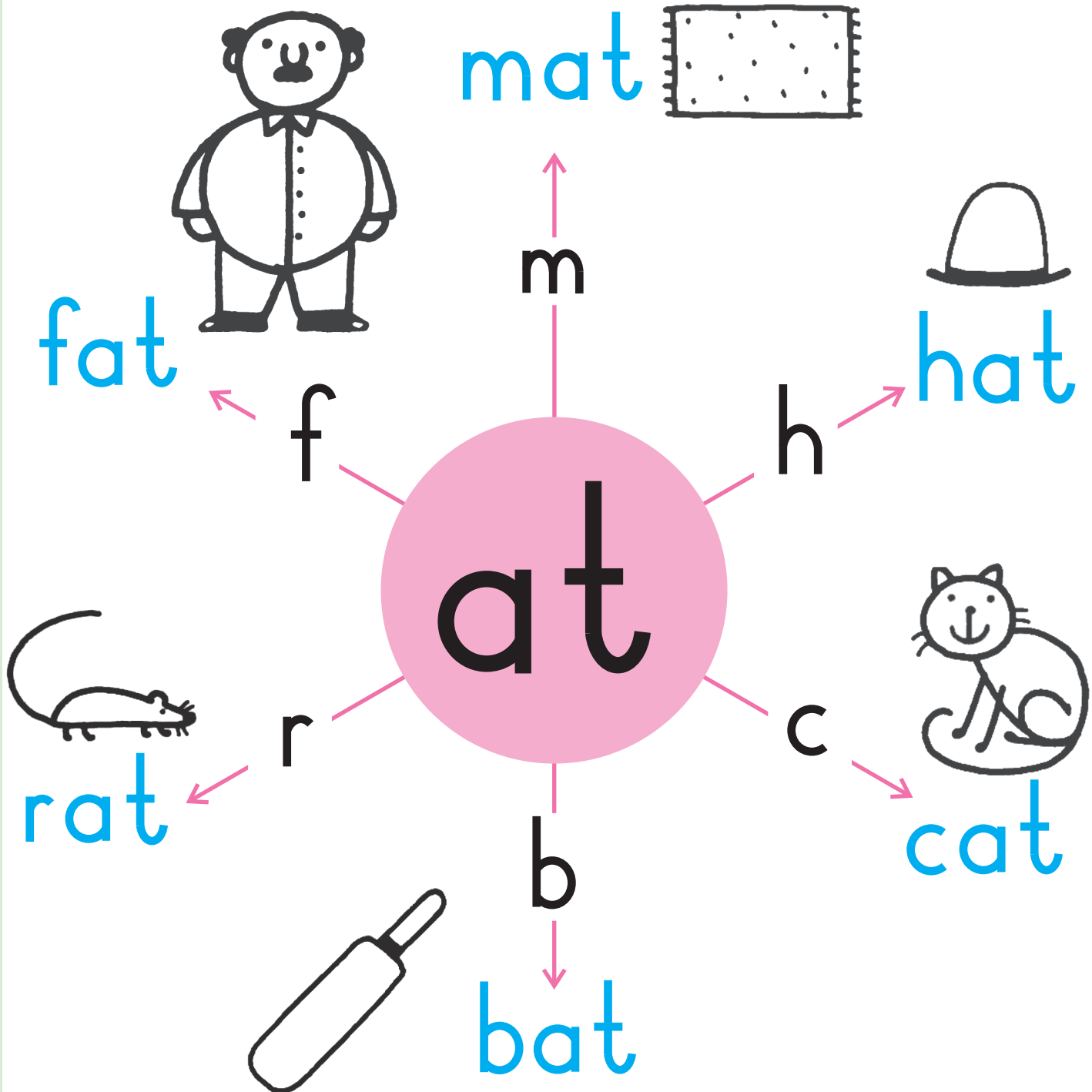


Words with the 'a' sound
